Cookies:

AKS Lining Systems (PTY) Ltd (“the Company”) uses cookies, pixels, and other technologies (collectively, “cookies”) to recognise your browser or device, learn more about your company or industry, and provide you with essential features and services, as well as for additional purposes, including:

1. Recognising you when you sign-in to use our services. This allows us to provide each user with customised features and services, if applicable.
2. Conducting research and diagnostics to improve the Company’s website content, products, and services.
3. Preventing fraudulent activity.
4. Improving security.
5. Delivering content, including ads, relevant to your interests.
6. Reporting. This allows us to measure and analyse the performance of our services.

You can manage browser cookies through your browser settings. The 'Help' feature on most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies; how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie; how to disable cookies; and when cookies will expire. If you disable all cookies on your browser, the Company, nor any of its third parties, will transfer cookies to your browser. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some features and services may not work.

Website Privacy:

Your privacy is important to the Company. This policy explains the Company’s privacy practices and the choices you have about the way your personal information (information that is capable of identifying an individual and hereinafter referred to as “personal information”) will be dealt with.

1. PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 1.1. Personal information is collected only when knowingly and voluntarily submitted.
- 1.2. Personal information is only used for the purpose for which it is submitted or such other secondary purposes that are related to the primary purpose.
- 1.3. In addition to where you have consented to the disclosure of your personal information, personal information may be disclosed in special situations where the Company has reason to believe that doing so is necessary to identify or act against anyone damaging or interfering with our rights or property, users or anyone else that could be harmed by such activities.
- 1.4. The Company may engage third parties to provide you with goods or service on our behalf and in such circumstances may disclose your personal information to such parties in order to provide such goods or services.

2. INFORMATION SECURITY ON OUR WEBSITE

- 2.1. Any information that you upload on our website will be stored on a secure server and be used for limited purposes such as future communications (which you are always entitled to un-subscribe to).
- 2.2. The Company will not disclose, sell or rent your personal information to third parties without your consent unless the Company is compelled to do so by law. The Company may do so if you have granted consent thereto.
- 2.3. While all reasonable efforts are taken to ensure that your personal information is protected as it travels over the internet, the Company cannot guarantee the absolute security of any information you exchange with us due to reasons beyond our control.
- 2.4. The Company may use cookies and web beacons to facilitate improvement of our website. However, neither cookies nor web beacons collect personal information such as the user’s name or email address. You may reject cookies, as most browsers permit individuals to decline cookies.

3. ACCESS TO INFORMATION

- 3.1. The Company will take all reasonable steps to keep secure any information which the Company holds about you and to keep this information accurate and up to date.
- 3.2. If at any time you discover that information held about you is incorrect, you may contact us to have the information corrected and updated.
- 3.3. Our employees together with our independent contractors who come into contact with our information systems are obliged to respect the confidentiality of any personal information held by us.
4. OUR COMMITMENT TO SECURITY
 - 4.1. The Company employs security measures to prevent unauthorised access to information that the Company may collect online. However, the Company cannot absolutely guarantee the security of your personal information.
5. REVISIONS TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY
 - 5.1. The Company may periodically update or change the terms of our privacy policy without notice. Please review the policy periodically for changes.
